We invite prayerful reflection on the CoB Statement on Abortion (1984) which includes the nuanced position "...the Brethren ideal upholds the sacredness of human life and that abortion should be accepted as an option only where all other possible alternatives will lead to greater destruction of human life and spirit."

We shared around tables at our Annual Conference Luncheon, and gathered for a Thinking Session online.

We heard a call from one another and the Holy Spirit to equip our church with caregiving skills, and we're partway through a training on Compassionate Care with the Religious Coalition for Reproductive Choice. Stay tuned for a future course.

No purse: no wallet, no backpack, no plastic, no cash, no tissues, no pens, no lipstick, no mirror, no keys, no gum.


No second tunic: no swim suit, no safety pins, no meds, no screwdriver, no pads, no condoms, nothing just in case.




- Thinkers include those interested in contributing to the knowledge base of Caucus by increasing our understanding of challenges facing women and the context in which those challenges exist.
